## **My Encounters..** Divine!

A gentleman in jeans and a T-shirt entered my office at Annamayyapuram, laptop bag slung over his shoulder. Towering and well-built, he was. He said, "I heard of you. Just wanted to see you."

I was pondering how he entered my office without permission. He delved into profound philosophy. I observed in awe. He said, "Your 'naa inta nilachipo Govinda!'
